All children in KS2 are taught French across the year. This is delivered through a scheme, Language Angels. Language Angels has just released a new, free app for children to access at home to support their learning, through songs and games. To access the app, visit the App Store and search for the Language Angels icon (see below). Your child's class teacher will talk to them about this in lessons and direct them to useful units.

Language Angels have created a simple login which all children can use to

access and use the app.
